What insurance companies will be in-network at opening?	The application process is underway. The timeline to be granted as an in-network provider is determined by each individual 3rd party payer's process
If you have a 25-bed hospital, how many doctors/Pas/FNP will you have on staff?	We are currently meeting with our community providers to establish credentialing to support the 24/7 hospital services.
Will the ER be open 24 hours?/What are the hours of the Emergency Room?	The Emergency Room will be open 24 hours 7 days a week.
Will there be any wellness programs?	A Wellness program will be part of the hospital as we grow. At the initial opening, Lab, Radiology, Respiratory, the Emergency Room and the 4th floor Medical-Surgical floor will be open to accept patients.
Are you profit or non-profit?	Americore is a for profit corporation.
What level trauma center will the ER be classified as? A Level II or III?	The Emergency Room will not be classified as a trauma center at this time.
Will you have diabetes treatment and management?	We are working with local agencies and community to determine education needs for specific disease treatment and management.
Will you have diet and nutrition classes?	We will assess community needs as the hospital grows and diet and nutrition classes may be one area that we can review for potential services.
Are you having any specialty doctors?	Once the hospital is open, we will work toward providing specialty services to serve the community.
Will you be accepting TriCare for Veterans?	We are working the VA to become a recognized provider.
Will you be credentialed with all commercial insurances and Medicaid MCOs?	The application process is underway for all insurances including Medicaid. The timeline to be granted as an in-network provider is determined by each individual 3rd party payer's process.
What about telemedicine?	Telemedicine will be a service that the hospital will utilize to provide care to our patients. The first telemedicine service will be partnering with another healthcare service to provide stroke telemedicine through the Emergency Room. Telemedicine services will expand as areas of need are identified.
What communities will you serve?	Our primary focus is serving the Lee County residents and visitors. We welcome surrounding counties as well to visit and utilize our facility.
